The Nice conference follows 10 successful GIMS conferences in Edinburg, UK (1990); Hirtshals, Denmark (1992); Texel, the Netherlands (1994); Varna, Bulgaria (1996); Bologna, Italy (1998); St Petersburg, Russia (2000); Baku, Azerbaidjian (2002); Vigo, Spain (2005); Bremen, Germany (2008) and Listvyanka, Russia (2010).

The program includes 48 oral and 43 poster presentations.
